*(C) Looks like diamonds (G) shining in the (C) night
Whippoorwills (E7) singing in the (F) white oak
(C) Coon dogs barkin' (G) in the bright moon-(C)-light

Chorus

*(F) Honeysuckle smells just like (C) sweet perfume
(F) Old dogs lyin' over by the (C) door
(F) Watermelon rinds mamma (C) puts up in a jar
And the city folks, (F) they call us (C) poor*

Instrumental: Follow pattern of any verse

(C) Singin' Rock Of (E7) Ages on the (F) front porch
(C) Watchin' fireflies (G) light up the mountain (C) dew
Listenin' to Bill Mon-(E7)-roe on the (F) Opry
(C) Singin' somethin' (G) 'bout his Uncle (C) Penn

Repeat Chorus

Instrumental: Follow pattern of any verse

(C) God he paints a (E7) picture in the (F) evenin' sky
(C) Blue and purple, (G) orange and shades of (C) red
He knows we can't af-(E7)-ford no fancy (F) paintings
So (C) we look at the (G) real thing in-(C)-stead
